



AAA TRAVEL LAUNCHES PREMIER POST-WAR CRUISE

In cooperation with the College of the Pacific in Stockton, California, AAA Travel organizes the nation's first tour of the Mediterranean and Near East following World War II.

After World War II, the mood in the United States was one of increasing optimism. As the pace of life began to accelerate, focus turned toward European travel. Americans started looking beyond their borders for vacation options, and AAA Travel fulfilled their dreams by sponsoring tours to exciting and exotic locations.

One of the first post-war cruises was a cooperative effort between AAA Travel and the College of the Pacific. Bound for the eastern Mediterranean, it promised to be one of the most comprehensive and exploration-rich trips of its time.

The journey began with a transcontinental rail trip from the West Coast on June 20, 1949. Upon arrival in New York, participants in the tour boarded the S.S. Khedive Ismail, a newly refurbished ship staffed by British

officers. After 10 days at sea, the ship reached Marseille, its first port of call.

From there it sailed to Genoa and the Italian Riviera. Naples and the ruins of Pompeii. Egypt, Beirut, and Damascus. It cruised among the islands of the Aegean Sea, through the Dardanelles Strait in Turkey, and on to the historic mosques, museums, and bazaars of Istanbul. Additional overland trips carried travelers to Cairo's pyramids and Rome's cathedrals before departing on July 31 for the return transatlantic trip. The ship arrived in New York on August 9—more than six weeks after the cruise began.

This sea and land expedition was just the beginning of AAA Travel's commitment to carry people all over the globe, helping them to satisfy their travel passions and dreams.

THE EVOLUTION OF CRUISING WITH AAA TRAVEL

From steamships to jets ... from weeks to hours ... travel between the U.S. and the rest of the world has come a long way in 60 years.

In the late 1940s, an article in *Motorland* magazine, now VIA, informed AAA Members, "Your association is now equipped to assist you in taking any kind of trip to almost any point in the world." Indeed, AAA Travel was sponsoring tours that included the spectacular and the sublime, with destinations that ranged from Egypt to England, Paris to Peru, Milan to Dijon.

By 1950, the membership of the California State Automobile Association (CSAA) stood at 200,000. And as the membership increased, so did the offerings of AAA

Travel. New destinations were featured, including Hawaii, Alaska, Mexico, South America, and around-the-world tours. While passenger ships grew larger and faster, the popularity of jet travel increased. AAA Travel gained distinction as the country's top provider of airline reservations, and CSAA Members numbered 400,000 by the end of the decade.

In the 1960s, ships changed their focus from crossings to cruises, to compete with air travel. Movie theaters, driving ranges, swimming pools, casinos, show

lounges, and a host of new amenities were added. With the expansion of the cruise industry, AAA Travel's expertise in this arena rose to the forefront. Of the 2.8 million Americans holding valid passports, 57 percent were AAA Members.


The 1970s represented the birth of the modern cruise industry. Many new ships were introduced on established routes such as the Caribbean and the Mediterranean, and destinations, particularly Mexico and Alaska, were added on a mass scale. Vessels were also getting larger, and







passenger capacity was expanding to 1,000 and beyond.

In the 1980s, cruise operators continued to refine onboard amenities, adding several features that are considered standard today: fitness and spa facilities, balcony and veranda cabins, and alternative dining

options that included 24-hour cafés, specialty restaurants, and round-the-clock room service.

The 1990s was the decade of the mega-ships—85,000- to 100,000-ton vessels capable of carrying 2,000 passengers. Greater emphasis was placed on shipboard

features and activities, including expanded casinos, golf, entertainment venues, spas, and fitness facilities, and the introduction of sports bars and art auctions.

With the new millennium have come the first 100,000-ton-plus, 3,000-passenger ships, offering specialty restaurants and

AAA TRIPTIK® ROUTINGS—TAKING TO THE HIGHWAYS

There's pleasure, relaxation, and adventure awaiting you down the road—especially if you take the long way home.

To help drivers successfully navigate a road trip, AAA produced the first TripTik in 1937. Travel counselors—armed with information from "pathfinders" who journeyed along the roads to measure distances and record conditions—outlined the recommended route on a large map. Individual "strip maps" were then pulled from the AAA library and bound into a compact book, indicating areas of construction, detours, and road closures.

In the 1940s, the federal government and the states embarked on a program to construct a 40,000-mile network of super-highways. Designed for both speed and safety, these roads afforded easy access to virtually every vacation area in the country—eventually expanding into Canada and Mexico.


The highways led to parks and forests, where visitors could marvel at the beauty of Mother Nature ... to shrines and memorials, where great deeds were commemorated ... to quaint towns, where life was gentle ... to sun-drenched beaches, where relaxation was the order of the day.

By the 1950s, AAA Members were enjoying these excursions with the help of TripTik routings, which were fast becoming a popular form of automobile navigation. Accompanied by AAA TourBook® guides, travel folders, a list of AAA-Approved accommodations, and an emergency services directory, they provided a complete resource for travelers.

Today, the formula of yesteryear has been adapted and automated, and

Members can now customize TripTik routings online. In addition to driving directions and accommodation details, our online services also include traffic information and weather reports.

TripTik routings are one indication of how AAA Travel keeps pace with the ever-changing needs of Members. Over the past 60 years, we have made enormous strides in the scope of services we provide. As we look toward the next bend in the road, you can be sure we'll be ready to meet whatever lies ahead.
